## RECIPE

### CANTALOUPE BREAD

#### **Ingredients :**

3 Eggs, beaten  
1 cup vegetable oil  
2 cups granulated sugar  
3 tsp Pure Vanilla extract  
1 Cantaloupe cut into small chunks, pureed  
(2 cups of puree, leave a few bits of fruit)  
3 cups of All purpose Flour  
1 tsp salt  
1 tsp baking soda  
3 /4 tsp baking powder  
2 tsp ground cinnamon  
1 cup chopped walnuts.



#### **Directions:**

mix eggs, oil, sugar and vanilla  
add pureed cantaloupe to mixture  
sift dry ingredients; add to liquid  
pour into 2 greased and floured 9x5 loaf pans  
bake at 325 degrees for 1 hour or until done,  
check after 50 minute  
(optional bake into muffins for 25-30 minutes)  
freezes well too

"Ctr+Alt+Delete" and start all over?

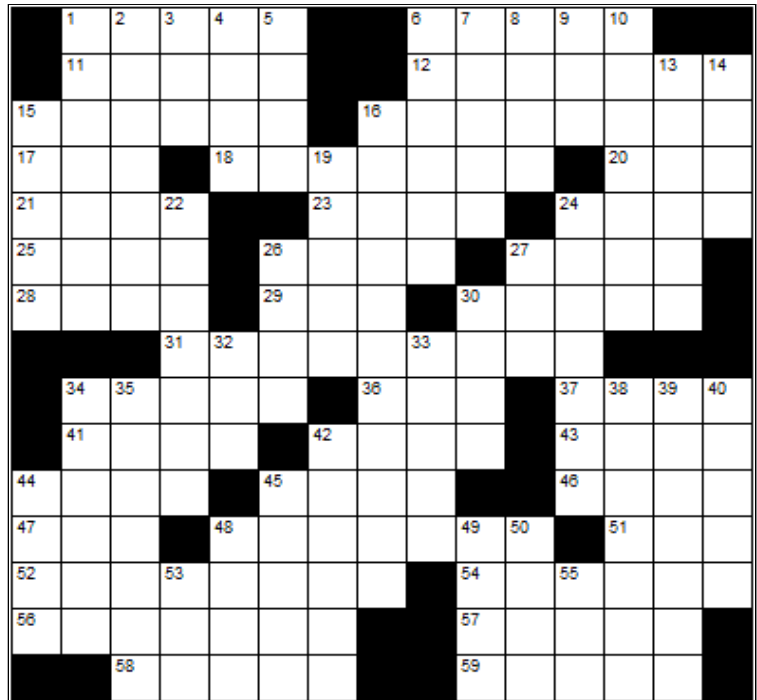
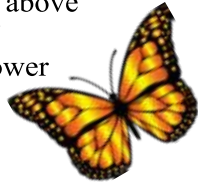

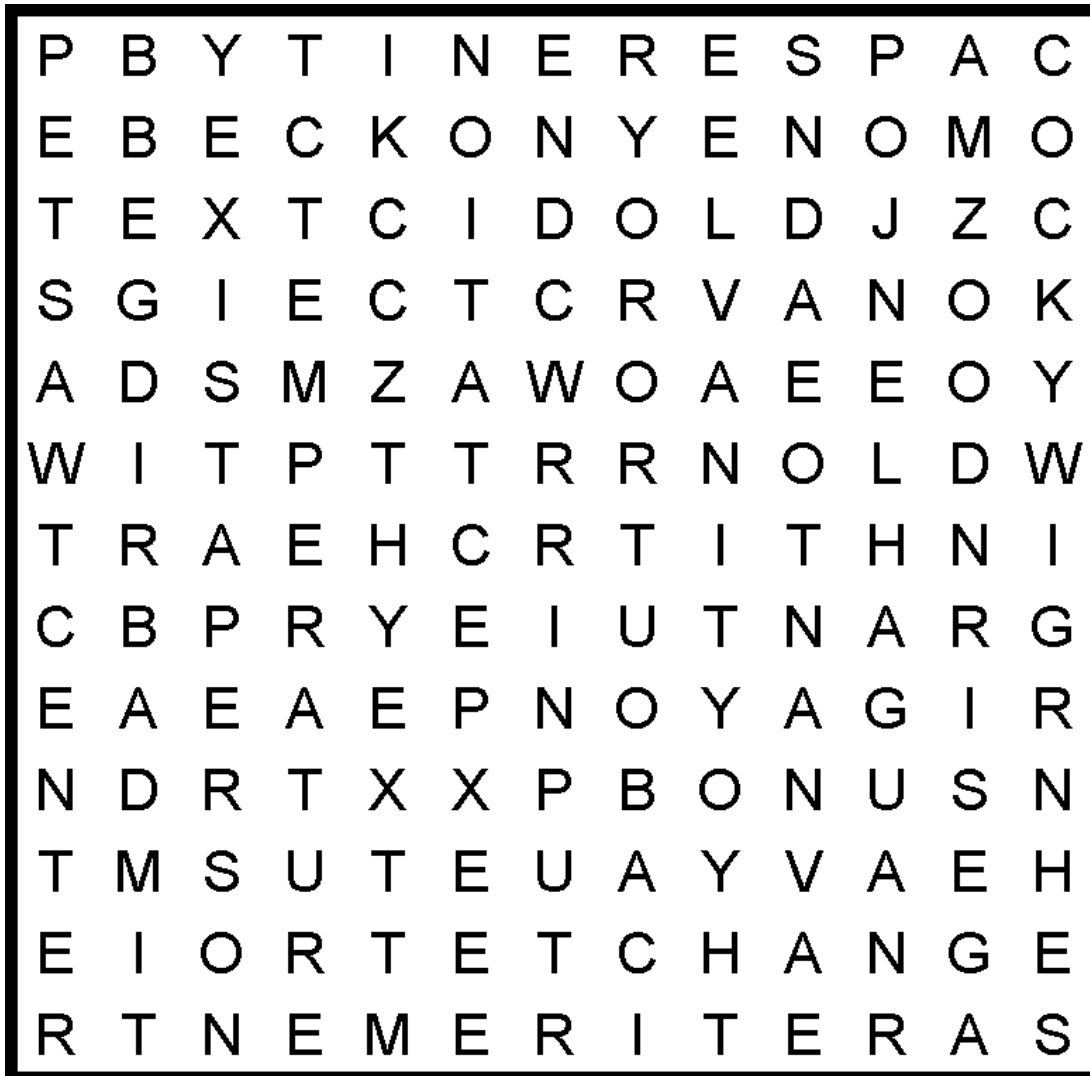
