



#### MOM'S ZUCCHINI BREAD

Yields 2 loafs

- 3 cups all purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon salt (optional)
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 1 Tablespoon ground cinnamon
- 3 eggs
- 1 cup vegetable oil
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- $2\frac{1}{4}$  cups white sugar
- 3 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 2 cups grated zucchini
- 1 cup chopped walnuts (optional)
- Grease and flour 2, 8x4 inch pans. Preheat oven to 325 degrees.
- 2. Sift flour, salt, baking soda, baking powder and cinnamon together in bowl.
- In large bowl, beat eggs, oil, vanilla & sugar together. Add sifted ingredients to the creamed mixture and beat well. Stir in zucchini and nuts until well combined. Pour into prepared pans.
- 4. Bake for 40 to 60 minutes, or until tester inserted in the center comes out clean. Cool in pan 20 minutes. Remove bread from pan and cool completely.
