(This information is taken directly from the www.hernandosheriff.org website. There is more information available there).

"To participate in the CARE LINE program, one must complete an application. The application, properly completed, also serves as an agreement to comply with the procedures necessary to make the program successful. A waiver is included as well. When signed, the waiver authorizes a Hernando County Sheriff's deputy to make forced entry (if no key is available) into a residence to check the well-being of the client. There is NO COST to participate."
